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Notice Inviting Budgetary offer

The Chennai Port Trust proposes to Lease the Pickup vehicles with towing facilities pay load capacity not less than 1 Ton with seating capacity not less than 5 (4+1) BS IV on Dry Lease Basis (without Driver & Fuel) on 24 hours basis for the use of Chennai Port Fire Service for using Fire/Fire related works and it operated by Trust Fireman drivers.

Budgetary Offer:

2. Scope of the work by the Trust (on 24 hours basis):

- 1) The Trust will be providing their own drivers
- 2) Trust will be providing the consumable like fuel& water and shelter free of cost.
- 3) The control monitoring and verification and processing of the bill shall be done by the respective department officials.
- 4) Monthly log book shall be maintained by the respective department officials for due verification and certification.

3. Scope of work by the vehicle operator:

The Successful Bidder shall supply 1 No. Pickup Vehicle(Non A/c) with towing facilities pay load capacity not less than 1 Ton with seating capacity not less than 5 (4+1) BS IV on Dry Lease Basis (without Driver & Fuel) on 24 hours basis for the use of Chennai Port Fire Service for using Fire/Fire related works and it operated by Trust Fireman Drivers.

- 1) These vehicles will be registered in the name of firm and leased under Operating Lease Agreement.
- 2) Comprehensive insurance cover for the vehicles and the driver and persons traveling in the Leased vehicles throughout the contract period shall be taken by the successful bidder.
- 3) Road tax, Insurance and other statutory duties & taxes as applicable for the entire period of the contract shall be paid by the vehicle operator and shall be duly valid.
- 4) Fleet Management Services: The successful Bidder shall take the responsibility of the entire management of the vehicle including replacement of tyres, tubes, batteries, spares, electrical & Mechanical maintenance and other breakdown repairs etc. A proper maintenance schedule shall be established for all the vehicles and furnished along with Cover I.
- 5) RTO formalities shall be taken care by the vehicle operator at the Tenderer Cost.
- 6) The vehicle operator shall pay applicable taxes, duties and get fitness certificate at their cost during the contract period.

- 7) The 1 No. pickup vehicle shall be required to be operated during 365 days in a year.
- 8) The successful Tenderer shall take care of the safety & security of his vehicle.
- 9) Only Tamil Nadu registration vehicles will be considered.
- 10) The vehicle operator shall execute necessary lease agreement.
- 11) Any accident to be informed to the official concerned and also to the police/ CISF and safety officer.
- 12) The vehicles shall be kept clean, fit & trim condition.
- 13) The Brake unit, steering control shall be always kept in good condition.

14) Replacement of Vehicles:

In case the Vehicles are held up in the workshop for periodical maintenance or any other repair and maintenance for more than 24 hrs, then replacement of alternative Equivalent Vehicle should be provided.

15) PAYMENT:-

CHPT will arrange monthly payment of the bills complete in all respects within 30 days from the date of receipt of the bills in duplicate and the bill duly signed and certified by the competent authority.

The applicable service tax will be reimbursed on submission of relevant documents.

The contractor shall give the PAN No. for I.T deduction at source. The contractor shall give the Bank Account Details for the payments through ECS.

16) Penalty:

If the similar alternate vehicle is not provided during the breakdown / maintenance period the following penalty charges shall be levied.

- i) If break down period is within 24 hours the penalty shall be calculated and deducted on hourly basis or part thereof by dividing the daily hire rate by twenty four (24).
- ii) No payment will be made for the non-deployment of vehicle for any particular day.
- iii) If the vehicle remains non-operational due to break down or for any other reason continuously, then penalty will be levied as follows in addition to non –payment of hire charges:
